Shiraz / Cab / Merlot



Excerpt of the winemaking team's tasting notes

The Two Left Feet is looking amazing with real complexity of aromas on the nose. It really displays our fruit flavour spectrum, showing beautiful dark berry and plum fruit with lots of spice. The palate is round and filling and has concentrated sweet fruits with layers of chocolate and cream. It is such a wonderful example of how Shiraz (The Boxer), Cabernet (The Maitre D') and Merlot (The Scooter) can be blended together to fully complement each other. Two Left Feet has always been a stand out for me and this vintage is exceptional. *Candice*

Technical notes

The grapes were grown on the Mollydooker vineyards in McLaren Vale.
Barrel fermented and matured in 96% American and 4% French oak using 56% new and 44% one year old barrels.
