We make Two Left Feet after making The Scooter, The Maitre D' and The Boxer. After tasting each wine we make a blend from them. The blend is usually slightly different every year, each vintage of the wine seems to 'speak' to us and tell us what it needs for perfect harmony. Sometimes it calls for more Scooter than Maitre D' and sometimes the other way round. This year we have 1% more Cabernet than Merlot! The McLaren Vale grapes in the blend were harvested between 9th March and 5th April and the Langhorne Creek grapes on 23rd and 24th March.

Scores & Reviews

Made of 69% Shiraz, 16% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 15% Merlot, the deep garnet-purple colored 2012 Two Left Feet Shiraz Blend displays lovely black fruit compote aromas with some spice box, licorice and pepper. Full-bodied and rich, it has spicy, concentrated fruit flavors supported by low to medium levels of velvety tannins and lively acidity. It finishes long. Drink it now to 2018. *Lisa Perrotti-Brown, Wine Advocate*

Totally opaque black dark red colour with deep dark red dark purple hue. Lifted aromas of ripe blackberry, dark plum and liquorice emerge on the nose which shows excellent intensity followed by some toasty vanillin oak and spice nuances. Big bold succulent flavours of ripe blackberry, cassis and dark plum burst onto the palate with some toasty oak and spice on the back palate. Voluptuously textured with velvet smooth tannins. Long flamboyant aftertaste of ripe blackberry, cassis, dark plum, toasty oak and spice. Drink over the next 3-4 years (2013-2017). *Nick's Wine Merchants, 96 pts*
