The parcels of wine in The Boxer this year come from Chapel Hill, Kirwin, Semmens, Birchmore and our own Mollydooker Home blocks and Coppermine Road blocks. The slightly cooler climate grapes from the Birchmore vineyards in Langhorne Creek, add a floral lift and elegance.

Winemaker's tasting notes

This Boxer is astounding, so rich and so smooth and so powerful. Succulent berry flavours with luscious chocolate layers as well as licorice and spice. The deep dark colour of the wine matches the deep flavours of the wine. 2013 Boxer is rounded and full on the pallet and the perfect balance of tannins and fragrant oak support the impressive fruit. The Shiraz brings so much character and complexity in 2013 that the Boxer will be applauded by all who drink it. *Matt Walker-Brown*
